Do I have to pay a  
Registration Fee?

No, you will not be required to pay the registration fee to attend the International Prophetic Prayer Conference. However, we welcome you to give your offering to support the preparation costs which includes; Tents, Food, Transport, Generator, Music Instruments, Mattresses, Water, Toilets, etc.

# TRAVEL & PREPARATIONS



When would I need to travel to Tanzania?

Depending on where you are arriving from, you may need up-to 30 hours on transit. We encourage you to plan to land in Tanzania on **19 February 2025**.

Can I get a direct flight into Kilimanjaro International Airport?

Most flights land directly into Kilimanjaro International Airport. Would you like for one of our team members to help you book your flights and curate your itinerary? Please indicate in the Online Registration Form, or inform our Diaspora Director and we will contact you as soon as possible.

What are the immigration requirements?

Some of our international guests will require visas and some are visa exempt, including the EAC and SADC countries. Please [click here](#) to see the full list.

Tanzania's visas are upon arrival. However, some countries may acquire an [Electronic Visa](#) which allows eligible foreign citizens to obtain travel authorization exclusively online.

To get a Visa upon arrival you will need;

- A valid passport with at least six months before expiry, with two free, adjacent pages in your passport.
- Proof of yellow fever vaccination- see country list.
- For non-US nationals, a visa on arrival costs \$50, and for US citizens, it costs \$100

What do I need to carry for the International Prophetic Prayer Conference?

Please carry all personal hygiene and essentials for example; toiletries, a portable neck pillow, twin-size sheets, and travel warmer/blanket.

Additionally, you may wish to bring below by faith. These are only suggestions and the list is not exclusive

1. Small amounts of soil from your house/home, workplace, business, school and land.
2. CV, Work Contract, Passport, Bank Cards, Business License etc.
3. Photo/Cloth for the person you are praying for.
4. Make sure you carry your Dream Book. A book/diary where you write all your dreams or visions.
5. Sacrificial Seed/Offering

# ARRIVAL AND ACCOMODATION



## At the Airport

When you arrive, you will be met at the airport by Divine Ministries' Hospitality team and transferred to your designated accommodation if arriving on or before 20 February 2025, and straight to the Prayer Conference if arriving on 20 February 2025.

The trip from the airport to Arusha town is about an hour. Please let us know in the registration form if there is any special preparation we should curate to make your transfer as comfortable as can be. Transfer fee is 50\$ per trip making it a total of 100\$ go and return.


## Where will I stay if I choose to arrive earlier/depart later?

Tanzania is renowned for its kind, and hospitable people, as such we have a number of options;


- Stay at our Divine Royal Residence at a cost of \$60 per night.
- Stay at our former House of Prayer- we have two shared rooms that accommodate up to Six people per room. These rooms are furnished with a 3\*4" mattresses only. Please carry your own beddings/pillows. This option is mainly reserved for guests who exclusively want to be in the presence of God throughout their stay in Tanzania.
- Book a Hotel/Airbnb at your own expense. Our Hospitality team will be happy to discuss with you a range of reputable accommodations options suited to your preference and budget.

# THE UNITED REPUBLIC OF TANZANIA



## TRAVEL ADVISORY NO.15 OF 21<sup>st</sup> JANUARY 2025

On 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025, the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania (URT) declared the outbreak of Marburg Viral Disease (MVD) affecting Biharamulo district in Kagera region, in the North-Western part of the country 1450km and 1068km from Dar es Salaam and Arusha respectively. Following this outbreak, the Government of the URT has decided to implement and enhance public health measures to contain the epidemic and prevent further local and international spread in line with the International Health Regulation of 2005. Thus, the Government has prepared the Travel Advisory No. 15 of 21<sup>st</sup> January 2025 with immediate effect to implement effective measures related to local and international travel as follows:

1. All departing travellers from Kagera region will be required to truthfully fill out an online Traveller's Surveillance Form through <https://afyamsafiri.moh.go.tz>
2. All persons in contact with a case are being monitored regularly and prevented from leaving their places of isolation until cleared to travel by health authorities.
3. At any point of entry (airport, ground crossing or port), body temperature will be checked on all travellers and those with feverish conditions will be further evaluated by Port Health Authority.
4. All travellers will be provided with health information and a toll-free number **199** at points of entry and advised to self-monitor and report any signs and symptoms of MVD. Those with signs and symptoms will be tested and treated at designated Government health facilities.
5. All travellers and staff at points of entry should adhere to Infection Prevention and Control measures such as hand hygiene, keeping physical distancing and report any sign or symptom using the toll-free number **199**
6. All conveyance operators should adhere to exit screening measures implemented at points of entry in the country that include health screening, conveyance hygiene inspection, hand hygiene, use of alcohol-based sanitizers and reporting immediately of any traveller with any signs and symptoms to port health authority.

**NB: The Travel Advisory will be reviewed from time to time as the need arises.**

# INTERNATIONAL PRAYER GATHERING DIVINE LAND GENERAL GUIDELINE

## 1. Food, drinking water, First Aid.

- We will be fasting for all four (4) days. Food will be served during evenings only
- If you are sick, or have dietary restrictions, please let our Ministry leaders know and or arrange your meals
- Water will be served throughout the day during official breaks. Please do not take drinking water without permission
- You are not allowed to do any business at the gathering. Please keep your focus on seeking God throughout your time at the camp
- There will be a First Aid service by our approved medical doctors. Please see their desk next to registration, or ask any leader to guide you to the doctors.

## 2. Cleanliness and Hygiene:

- Keep the gathering space clean and litter-free. Dispose of trash in designated bins.
- Avoid littering or leaving personal items in common areas, including prayer and gathering spaces.
- Promote a culture of respect and cleanliness by setting a positive example.

## 3. Toilet Facilities

- Maintain cleanliness in all toilet facilities.
- Flush toilets after use and use the provided hand sanitisers or soap for handwashing.
- Report any issues or shortages of hygiene supplies to camp organisers.
- Designated shower areas should be treated with respect. Please ensure where you are showering is clean for the next person

## 4. Charging your phone

- Do not use the media section to charge your phone
- No area has been designated for charging. Please reserve your battery for use after the prayer gathering

## 5. Campsite Clean-Up:

- Be responsible for cleaning and organizing your personal areas where you sit/sleep.
- Ensure all communal areas are left clean and orderly after use.
- Respect the environment by refraining from damaging plants, trees, or any camp property.
- Keep pathways and walkways clear and free from obstructions.

## 6. Reporting Issues:

- If you see something say something, let us be accountable for each other
- Report any extreme issues to Divine leaders promptly.

## 7. Personal Responsibility:

- All our guests are personally responsible for keeping their belongings safe
- We are committed to ensuring a safe and spiritually uplifting experience for all our guests. Hence, your cooperation is essential.
